### **RISING STARS GALA CONCERT**

In addition, perhaps the most special part of the concert, will be the inclusion of a chorus from the Phenomenal Opera Voices – a group that Lunga brought together in 2009 and who are now continuing to bring change and music to the communities of Khayelitsha and beyond.
